Sports

At Branwood Preparatory School we are very proud of our sporting abilities and the wide variety of opportunities offered to our pupils.

All children are given P. E. and sporting tuition with a view to learning both individual coordination and co-operative teamwork. Our Sports Specialists provide all classes with a well planned, varied and progressive curriculum.

Our aim is to increase the opportunities available across a wide range of sporting disciplines. Through our ISA membership we provide many sporting competition opportunities and have had many success in National Finals at swimming, Cross Country and five-a-side-football as well as successes in netball and lacrosse.

A selection of the sports offered include football, netball, cross-country, hockey, gymnastics, dance, tennis, rounders, cricket, handball, volleyball, badminton, lacrosse, multi-skills, athletics and handball.

All children in Upper School participate in swimming lessons.





Music

We have an extensive music department which boasts a full time music teacher and two peripatetic music teachers, who provide individual tuition in a wide variety of musical instruments:

There are also opportunities for talented musicians to explore music theory lessons.

Each class has a weekly group music lesson and are given the chance to explore the world of music with a music specialist.

Our musicians regularly take part in musical performances for the parents and participate in the ABRSM pathway.





Forest School

We believe that it is important to consider the whole child and in order to give them the best possible opportunities we have teamed up with Forever Wild Forest School.

The sessions aim to broaden our provision and to support the on-going health & well-being of the children.

The sessions are delivered to the children on a fortnightly basis and allow them the freedom to explore the outdoors while being in a safe and secure environment. The range of activities is age appropriate and the Forever Wild Forest School have extensive experience in running these sessions.

The children are able to experience:

We are extremely lucky to have such an extensive site and all the activities take place on the copse area to the rear of the school grounds.
